### Important Information

Individuals who received one dose of COVID-19 vaccine since fall 2024 and who meet the criteria may receive an additional dose of COVID-19 vaccine, provided it has been at least three (3) months since their most recent dose:

- Adults 65 years of age and older;
- Indigenous people 45 years of age and older, including First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples, regardless of place of residence;
- Adult residents of long-term care homes and other congregate living settings for seniors;
- Individuals 6 months of age and older who are moderately to severely immunocompromised (due to an underlying condition or treatment).

The province has funded the tetanus-diphtheria vaccine for seniors in long-term care who are eligible for their booster.

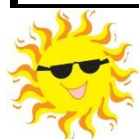
