


## About Betel Homes


In 1915, a small group of Icelandic women from the First Lutheran Church in Winnipeg, Manitoba recognized the need to provide supportive housing for the elderly in their community. Through their efforts and with the financial support of the Icelandic community, the first Betel Home opened its doors to nine residents on March 1, 1915, in rented quarters at 354 William Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba. Later in 1915 the "Home" was moved to permanent quarters in Gimli where over the years it expanded until it housed 95 residents. In 1990, a new 80-bed facility opened on this site.

In 1966, a second home was built at 212 Manchester Avenue in Selkirk, Manitoba to address the needs of that community. The Selkirk Betel Home was expanded in 1970.

Today the private, non-profit Betel Home Foundation owns and operates an 80 bed home in Gimli and a 91 bed home in Selkirk. We take great pride in our long history of caring for the elderly in our communities.

We are governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, licensed by Manitoba Health and are operationally funded by Manitoba Health through the Interlake Eastern Regional Health Authority as well as through resident per diems.

In the spirit of reconciliation, Betel Home Foundation acknowledges that we are located in First Nations Treaty 1 Territory, the ancestral territory of the Anishinaabe, Cree, Dakota, Dene and Oji-Cree and the traditional homeland of the Metis Nation.

# The Strategic Planning Process

Our planning process started with soliciting feedback by way of focused surveys with staff, residents, family members and community partners. Feedback from surveys was reviewed by the Board of Directors and discussed at subsequent strategic planning sessions.

Based on the survey feedback and the Board planning sessions, new Mission and Vision statements as well as definition of our strategic pillars were drafted and shared with staff, residents and families before they were finalized.

This was used to inform our Strategic Plan for 2025-2030 which was presented to the Board of Directors and approved on January 16, 2025

- We will operate in a fiscally responsible and transparent manner, accountable to our community



### Infrastructure and Facilities
